In his early years, he went to Stella Maris Convent, Basic Education High School Taunggyi, Basic Education High School (5) May Myo (Pyin Oo Lwin). He then pursued law at Yangon Arts & Science University.

After serving as a trainee lawyer, he served through different ranks and capacities under the Union Attorney General Office. He also served as executive member of People's Council, Kutkai and as a Secretary of Law and Order Restoration Group, Kutkai. From 1990 to 2010, while he served as a Division Director under the Union Attorney General Office, he also had to undertake the special duties as the leader of People's Militia Force Kutkai and Special Police Combat Unit under the command of the North-East Division Military Command. He was a member of the Constitution Drafting Commission, 2007 and the Constitutional Referendum Commission, 2008.

He got elected as a member of the Pyithu Hluttaw in the 2010 general elections for Kutkai Constituency. From 2011 to 2016, he served as the Chairman of the Bill Committee. In 2015 General Elections, he got re-elected as a member of the Pyithu Hluttaw representing Kutkai Constituency. In February 2016, he was elected and became the Deputy Speaker of Pyithu Hluttaw. After the resignation of the former Speaker and the incumbent President U Win Myint, Pyithu Hluttaw elected him as the next Speaker of Pyithu Hluttaw and was sworn in on 22 March 2018.
