National Initiatives to Encourage Clean Energy	Views on Possible Common Legislation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Singapore's initiatives to encourage Clean Energy are focused on Research, Development and Demonstration (RD&D) for clean energy technology. • Comprehensive Whole-of Government (WOG) approach adopted to clean energy and sustainable development. • Multi-agency Clean Energy Programme Office (CEPO) set up to implement and co-ordinate research and test-bedding public programmes. \$350m in funding provided to build R&D and manpower capabilities. • Provision of testbed facilities via the Clean Energy Research and Testbedding programme, which allows companies testbed clean energy technologies using government building and facilities. • \$25 million set aside for Clean Energy Scholarships established to train next generation of leaders for Clean Energy research and support growth of industry. • Ultimately Singapore's aim is to encourage companies to view Singapore as a 'living laboratory' to innovate urban solutions for clean and sustainable development. We therefore encourage companies to develop their ideas, prototypes, testbed and demonstrate their products and solutions in Singapore.
