

**Draft Resolution on the Report of the Women of ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly (WAIPA) Seminar on the Accelerating of the Achievement of the Millennium Development Goals – 5, through the Role of Women Parliamentarians**

The Thirty Second General Assembly:

**Recalling** Resolution 27GA/WAIPO/2006, on the Role of Women Parliamentarians in Achieving the Millennium Development Goals, which was adopted by the AIPO General Assembly in Cebu City, 10-15 September 2006, it encouraged all the ASEAN and AIPO member countries to support and fairly distribute their resources with women parliamentarians in the effort to integrate gender mainstreaming towards national agenda setting in all strategies, programs and policy making activities designed to achieve the targets of the Millennium Development Goals;

Being aware of the target to achieve the Millennium Development Goals in particular to the Achievement of MDG-5 by the year 2015, requires more commitment and collaborative efforts.

Acknowledging the initiative of the National Assembly of the Kingdom of Cambodia to organize a seminar in regard with the Accelerating of the Achievement of the Millennium Development Goals, particularly MDG-5 in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, March 9 – 12, 2011, and the meeting was convened successfully;

Hereby resolves to:
