Unified Aspirations: Transforming Women's Political Landscape in ASEAN

As we celebrate International Women's Day every year, we reflect on the progress made towards achieving greater gender equality. Over the past twenty-three years, the number of women in parliaments has almost doubled, increasing from 12 percent in 2000 to 22 percent in 2022. However, the regional average still lags slightly behind the global average of 26 percent. Unfortunately, the pace of progress is slowing down, and women continue to face challenges in increasing their participation in shaping policies and decision-making. Nevertheless, we can address these challenges collectively. It is the shared efforts and commitment to advancing gender equality in ASEAN that truly matter to all of us.

In 2023, during the 44th ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly (AIPA) General Assembly, the Women Parliamentarians of AIPA (WAIPA) Standing Committee adopted a resolution titled 'Enhancing ASEAN Resilience Through Women Leadership and Gender-Responsive Parliaments.' In accordance with this mandate, the AIPA Secretariat initiated a project to develop the first-ever ASEAN Plan of Action on Promoting Women's Political Participation and Leadership 2024-2030, along with its Implementation Framework. The plan outlines concrete actions structured around three pillars:

creating an enabling environment and safe space for women to participate and lead in politics; empowering women in politics; and fostering a gender-responsive parliament and decision-making process. The adoption of the Plan of Action at the forthcoming 45th AIPA General Assembly will mark a crucial milestone in creating a world where women's political participation and leadership leads to impactful and lasting change. This resonates with a unified commitment and aspiration to realize an inclusive ASEAN Community, leaving no one behind.

### **WAIPA EVENTS 2024**

From 5th to the 6th of February 2024, the ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly (AIPA) and the National Assembly of Lao PDR successfully hosted the WAIPA Events 2024, in Vientiane, Lao PDR. The events were made possible with the support from the Government of Canada under the Canada Fund for Local Initiatives (CFLI), and the Regional Project "Empowering Women for Sustainable Peace: Preventing Violence and Promoting Social Cohesion in ASEAN" implemented by UN Women and funded by the Governments of Canada, the Republic of Korea and the United Kingdom. #### **3RD WAIPA Coordinating Committee Meeting**

The 3rd WAIPA Coordinating Committee Meeting, chaired by Hon. Thoummaly Vongphachanh on 6 February 2024, marked the conclusion of WAIPA Events 2024. Distinguished AIPA Member Parliaments shared insights, experiences and strategies to propel women into key political roles, fostering a more inclusive and resilient ASEAN community, leaving no one behind. The meeting prepared for the upcoming 45th General Assembly and echoed

collective support for the draft Plan of Action (PoA) and Implementation Framework on promoting Women's Political Participation and Leadership (WPPL) 2024-2030.


