The Secretary-General of AIPA participated in the 148th Inter-Parliamentary Union Assembly in Geneva, Switzerland from 23 to 27 March 2024. Under the theme "Parliamentary Diplomacy: Building Bridges for Peace and Understanding", parliamentarians from all around the world gathered at this assembly to further foster dialogue and inspire parliamentary action.







8 AIPA Member Parliaments also participated in this assembly; Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Viet Nam. The AIPA Secretary General also had the opportunity to address the General Debate and deliver intervention at the Parity Debate, highlighting global challenges such as conflict, discrimination, and exclusion while promoting women's and youth's political participation.

Development of AIPALync - Digital Law Library



The AIPA Secretariat organized a Coordination and Briefing meeting with the AIPA National Secretariats to provide updates on the development of the AIPA Digital Law Library, named 'AIPALync.' 'AIPALync' aims to promote harmonization of laws and legislative transparency within ASEAN, consisting of three tiers of legal documents: ASEAN agreements, AIPA Resolutions, and National Legislations.

This endeavor encompasses a structured development approach involving the creation of a web-based framework, data collection, and integration with a mobile application.

AIPA Roadshow Bandung



Continuing our initiative to raise awareness among the youth, the AIPA Secretariat held the first AIPA Roadshow in 2024 at two esteemed universities in Bandung, West Java: the Padjadjaran University and the Parahyangan Catholic University. 


AIPA Secretariat's Engagement with Externals
