
In alignment with AIPA's commitment to promoting women's empowerment and gender equality, AIPA Secretary General H.E. Ar. Siti Rozaimeriyanty Dato Haji Abdul Rahman participated as a panelist in the Roundtable on Strengthening Women's Participation and Leadership in Asia-Pacific on 20 November 2024, held at the United Nations Conference Centre in Bangkok, Thailand. The roundtable brought together government officials, regional stakeholders, and international organizations dedicated to advancing women's empowerment and leadership.

During the session, the AIPA Secretary General highlighted AIPA's initiatives to enhance women's political participation, including the adoption of AIPA's first Plan of Action and Implementation Framework on Women's Political Participation and Leadership. This milestone document was developed in collaboration with UN Women during Lao PDR's AIPA Presidency in 2024. She further emphasized the importance of breaking barriers to support women in leadership, particularly in politics, and called for sustained collaboration to advance gender equality across the Asia-Pacific region.





During the AIPA Secretary General's participation in the Asia-Pacific Ministerial Conference on the Beijing+30 Review, a bilateral meeting was held with Ms. Christie Arab, UN Women's Asia-Pacific Regional Director. The discussion centered on exploring opportunities for collaboration and developing new initiatives to advance gender equality in the region, with a particular focus on the implementation of the recently adopted AIPA Plan of Action and Implementation Framework on Women's Political Participation and Leadership. This partnership reaffirms AIPA's dedication to driving meaningful progress in empowering women and promoting gender equality, contributing to a more inclusive, resilient, and equitable future across ASEAN.
